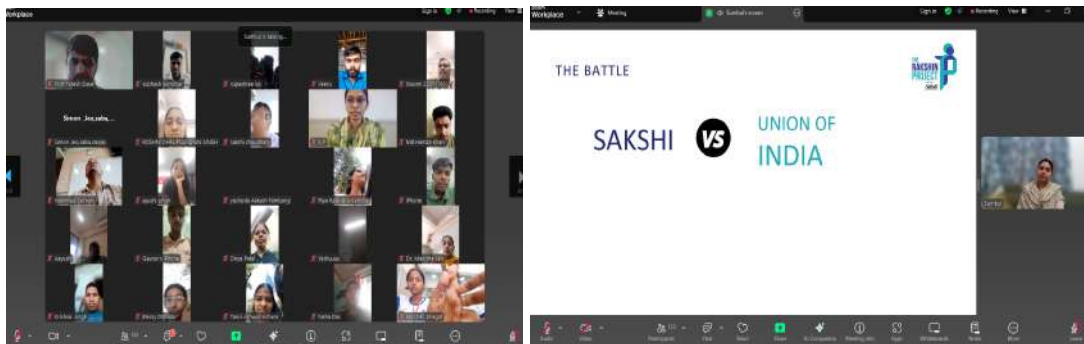


52. Rakshin: Youth Awareness on POSH & POCSO for Safer Space(25/02/26)

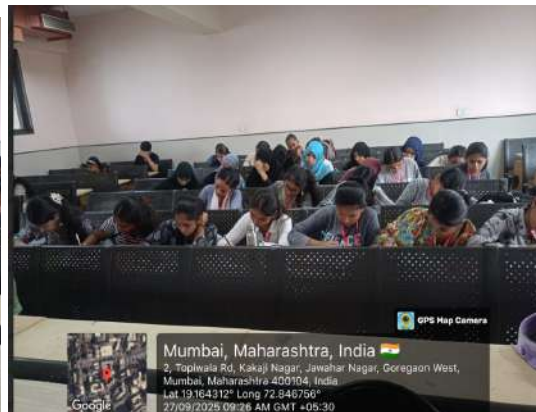

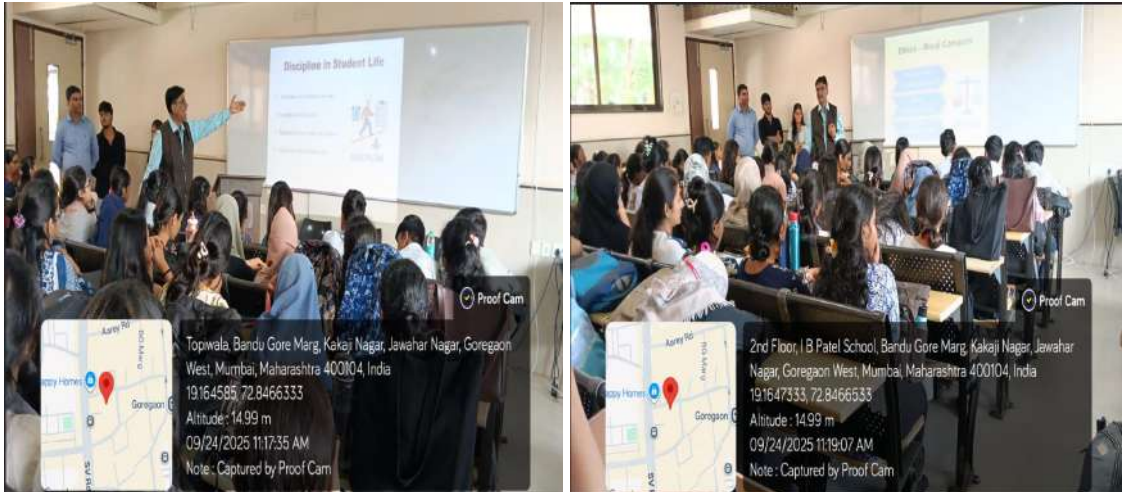
1. One Campus One Code: Student Oath for Harmony & Discipline (04/08/2025)

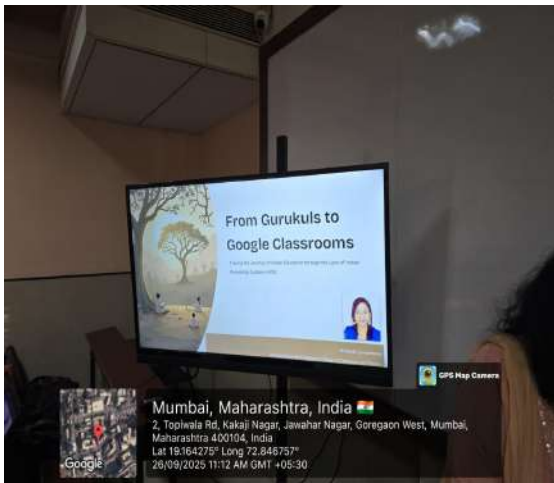
9. Photography Workshop (22/09/25)

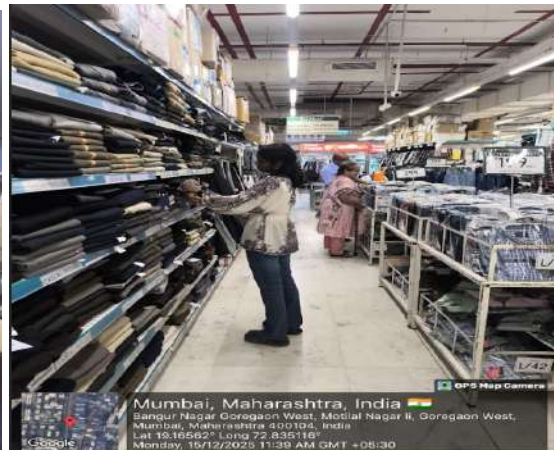

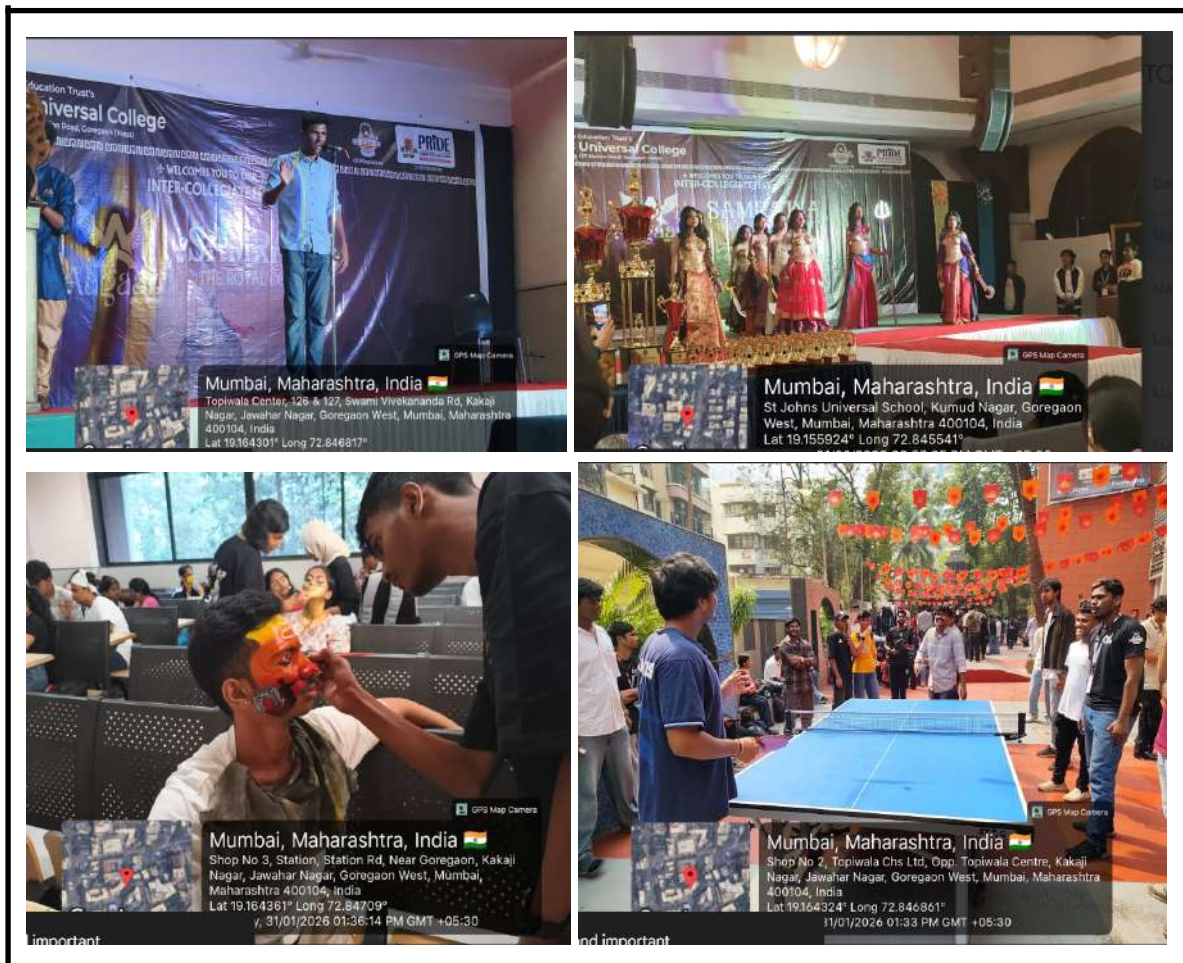

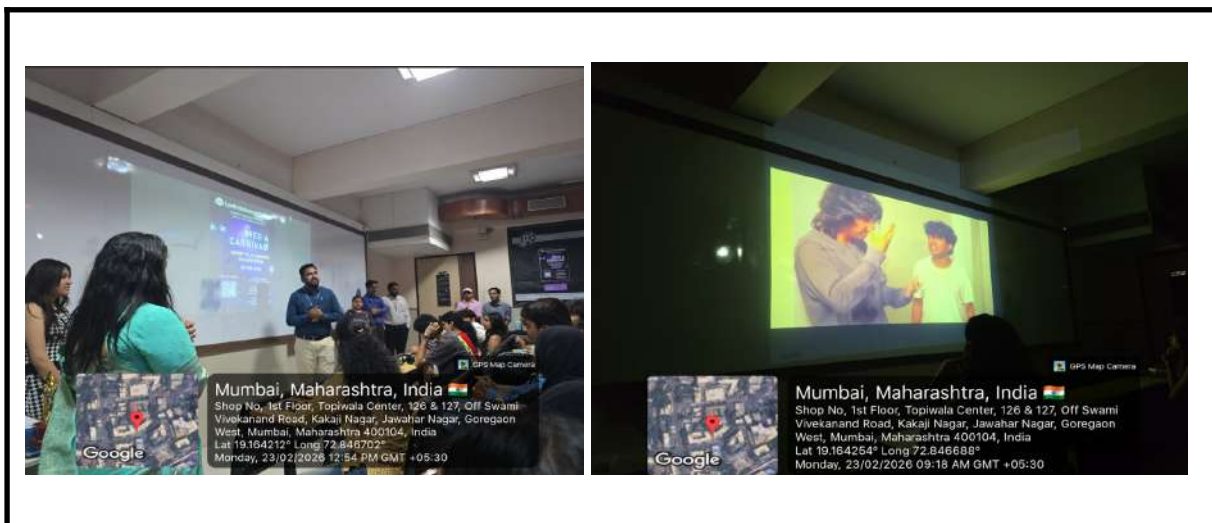
